Exploring Quilt Design: A Talk by Nancy Bardach • Tuesday March 15, 2016



Using quilts that range from realistic to semi-abstract to very abstract, Nancy will talk about how she gets ideas and goes from start to finish ... and how you can, too. She'll suggest many ways to design art quilts and many possible springboards to inspiration, such as

- Riffing on traditional patterns
- Taking inspiration from the theme of an exhibition she wants to enter
- Working from an eye-catching image
- Elaborating on an idea in a series
- Trying totally abstract starting points, including the Nancy Crow techniques of sew-cut-and-sew again, "making" fabric and then composing with it, and cutting shapes and composing with them

She'll show starting sketches and then radical changes to her pieces as an idea takes form in cloth. And she'll cover the nitty-gritty process of moving from first idea to research, composing and reworking, up to completion and exhibiting. The goal is to inspire you, encourage you and share some "how-tos" of creative work.
