










# Block of the Month: February block

Will be drawn at February 2015 meeting • Pick your favorite colors!

Using whites and colour prints, cut the following sizes (in the chart).

[1.] Sew pieces in numerical order. [2.] Stitch center piece 1 to piece 2 using a scant 1/4" seam allowance.

Numbers correspond to assembly:		
1.	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	white
2.	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	blue-green
3.	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	yellow-green
4.	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	yellow-gold
5.	2 1/2" x 6 1/2"	grey
6.	1 1/2" x 6 1/2"	white
7.	1 1/2" x 7 1/2"	white
8.	1 1/2" x 7 1/2"	white
9.	1 1/2" x 8 1/2"	white
10.	2 1/2" x 8 1/2"	grey
11.	2 1/2" x 10 1/2"	blue-green
12.	2 1/2" x 10 1/2"	yellow-green
13.	2 1/2" x 12 1/2"	red



Press seams open ----->

[3.] Stitch piece 3 to the block. Press seams open.

[4.] Continue to rotate the block and attach pieces in order as indicated in the diagram.

**February 6-8..... "Fabrics of our lives: Celebrating 38 years of quilts and fiber art"**






February 21<sup>st</sup>; 10 A.M. to 4 P.M. **Working with Large Scale Prints** with Kellie Neal.
