Hexies Made Easy

Saturday Sewcial • September 23, 2017

Create Hexie samplers, bags or quilts using Rami’s innovative, no-hand-sewing, quilt-as-you-go technique. We’ll start by learning Rami’s trick for making hexies ... simply by folding circles! Then participants can pursue one of three options, all using batiks or solids with front-and-back color:

OPTION 1. Continue making folded, padded hexagons and turn them into a potholder. You’ll need to bring ...

- Six precut 7" circles in one color
- One precut 7" circle in an accent color
- Enough fusible batting to suit the size of this project
- Bring extra precut circles ... just in case you’re inspired to make more!



OPTION 2. Begin work on Rami's *Zinfandel Bag*. You'll need to

- Bring 32 precut 7" circles in purple batik cotton
- Bring 14 precut 7" circles in yellow-green batik cotton
- Bring 14 precut 7" circles in yellow-brown batik
- Bring 14 enough fusible batting to suit the size of this project
- Pay a \$5 fee to Rami for the pattern (versus \$14 on the web!)



OPTION 3. Begin work on Rami's *Grandmother's Flower Garden Quilt*, pictured on Page 1. For this project, you can buy a kit that includes 213 precut circles! Or, you can opt to do the cutting yourself.

If you want to avoid cutting all those circles, you'll need to

- Pay an \$85 fee to Rami for 213 precut 6" circles (includes pattern)
- Bring enough fusible batting to suit the size of this project

If you want to save money and do the work yourself, you'll need to

- Pay a \$5 fee to Rami for the pattern
- Bring 213 precut 6" circles (from a total of 6¼ yards of fabric)
- Bring enough fusible batting to suit the size of this project

Other Supplies to Bring

- Sewing machine, cords, an iron and/or mini-iron, etc.
- Thread, pins, scissors and other standard sewing supplies
